Project Name: Petersburg, AK North Harbor Project

Project Location: Petersburg, AK

Project Description (please attach additional pages as required):

The State is seeking to divest itself of ownership of the harbors it owns, including North Harbor in Petersburg. It recently transferred title to the community as well as \$2.5 million to defray deferred maintenance costs. The harbor infrastructure is old, float system decrepit, and utilities aging. Furthermore the harbor channel has filled in to a depth of 9.5 feet. It was originally dredged by the Corps to 11 feet, the amount authorized under WRDA and the Corps. If it receives appropriations, the Corps can re-dredge the harbor to that depth without a new authorization. The community would like to time the dredging with the removal of the old floats so as to speed completion of the project and keep its costs down. The total cost of the project including dredging and installation of new floats, gangways and electrical/water utilities is \$6.24 million. The cost of the initial dredging is \$1 million according to the Corps. There could be some environmental mitigation associated with contaminated spoil that would push that cost higher. The AK Corps Regional Office supports the project, although that request did make it into the President's budget submission.

The community is proposing to expand its South Harbor in two phases to support increased commercial fishing and tour vessel operations. The South Harbor is also where the Marine Ferry comes in. Phase I will include dredging and sheet pile bulkhead construction. Phase II will include dock face completion, utilities, vehicle accessible float, and bridge and gangway.

The total project cost is projected at \$15 million including Federal and non-Federal shares. This year we are seeking \$500,000 in ACOE GI funding to explore the feasibility of the project before pursuing a project authorization in the next WRDA Bill.
