Project Name: Water System Improvements-Expansion

Project Location: Wasilla, Alaska

Project Description (please attach additional pages as required):

This request will provide funding for a 1.2 mile water main extension to Garden Terrace Subdivision with 50 homes, a 0.5 mile water main extension to Mission Hills subdivision with 100 homes, and water improvements consisting of connecting a new well, booster pumps, backup power, and main line extension along Palmer-Wasilla Highway.

This project is the City's number one priority due to the need to improve water service to homes in Garden Terrace Subdivision where corrosive well water leaches copper into the drinking water supply, to improve water quality in Mission Hills Subdivision where the well water contains low level arsenic, and to add overall water system redundancy by connecting a new well to the municipal water system along the Palmer-Wasilla Highway.

Project Name: Sewage Treatment Plant Expansion

Project Location: Wasilla, Alaska

Project Description (please attach additional pages as required):

This request will provide design and construction funding to expand the municipal sewage treatment plant from its current capacity of 0.6 million gallons per day to 1.0 million gallons per day. A design study is currently underway to define the best method for expansion.

Expanding the municipal sewage treatment plant helps preserve water quality in the area by allowing development to connect to the municipal system that provides a higher level of treatment versus development occurring with onsite septic systems. In addition, economic development is driven by having municipal water and sewage utilities available. This project will allow development to continue until a regional sewage treatment plant can be constructed.

This request will provide design and construction funding to expand the municipal sewage treatment plant from its current capacity of 0.6 million gallons per day to 1.0 million gallons per day. A design study is currently underway to define the best method for expansion.

Project Name: South Mack Drive Extension

Project Location: Wasilla, Alaska

Project Description (please attach additional pages as required):

This request will provide final design funding and phase one construction funding to extend S. Mack Drive 1.5 miles south to Knik-Goose Bay Road as a 2-lane arterial. The City has constructed 0.6 miles of this future arterial to the Multi-Use Sports Complex.

This project is identified in the City's Official Streets and Highway Plan as a major future arterial for the Borough's core area. In addition, planners from the State, Borough, and City have identified added benefit to this project if it can align with Fairview Loop at Knik-Goose Bay Road.

An alignment with Fairview Loop would optimize use of a future traffic signal on Kink-Goose Bay road by serving arterials on each side of the road. This alignment would also provide a north-south transportation route from the Little Susitna River to the Hayflats.

This request will provide final design funding and phase one construction funding to widen Lucille Street from the current 2-lane facility to a 4-lane facility 1.3 miles north from the Parks Highway to Spruce Avenue.

This project addresses the need to have an improved north-south transportation network in the Borough's core area. Presently, east-west traffic movement is facilitated by the Parks Highway, Palmer-Wasilla Highway and Seldon Road.

Widening Lucille Street is part of an area wide plan to improve north-south traffic movements that include Seward Meridian Parkway improvements, South Mack Drive Extension, and Trunk Road improvements.
