This project will provide critical funding to allow the IFA to keep operating this ferry system. The system is support by the FTA which has funded the construction of both IFA ferries and provides funding support for IFA operations. The funding fully aids navigation for connects the nation's 3rd largest island to the rest of the state and the country.

This project will accomplish three things; 1) perform maintenance dredging from under the transfer bridge float at the Hollis, Alaska IFA Terminal and provide a diversion wall or sump for future maintenance dredging; 2) provide a source of standby generated power to the Hollis terminal; and 3) complete the asphalt surfaces and painting of the terminal parking and staging areas.
